# Cricklands Derby Show: Jumping Classes

## Castle / Popular Arenas Derby Classes (1200-1211 & 2200-2211)

Entry Fee: £15 (Derby entries will close before the show, please enter soon to avoid disappointment)

Prizes: Medals & Vouchers for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>

Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup>

PLUS Special Commemorative Rosette to those that clear The Joker Fence

All riders will start in the Popular Ring. There will be approximately 10 fences, including banks, dykes, and water troughs. This section will be timed. Riders that complete this section of the course without any faults will then be allowed to jump out of the arena and then jump into the Castle Arena. Once in the Castle Ring, riders will complete other fences, including the table, the bank and perhaps the big hedge. This section of the course will not be timed. The Castle Ring will also include a Joker Fence, which may be the hedge in the bigger classes. Although this fence is not compulsory, anyone who clears the fence will be given a Special Commemorative Rosette.

The winner of the class will be determined by the rider that collects the fewest faults in the Castle Arena. Obviously, only riders that jump clear in the Popular Ring will be able to jump in this section. In the event of a tie in the number of faults in the Castle Arena, the rider that completed the course in the Popular Ring the fastest will be the winner.

There will be a different set of rosettes and medals for Junior and Senior riders so please enter the correct class. Juniors are riders that were 16 & under on 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2017. Horses and Ponies will compete on equal footing for the Junior and Senior placings.

## The Superflex Arena Classes (1212-1223 & 2212-2223)

Entry Fee: £10

Prizes: Rosettes to 6th, Vouchers to Winners

These classes will be run Single Phase. This is a course of usually about 12 fences. Regardless of how many fences a rider has down in the first section, they still go forward to the second half of the course which is timed. Any faults accrued in the first section are added to the faults and time for the second section. If you would like any further information, please ask one of the staff.

Seniors riding ponies must jump in the senior classes, and will be awarded a separate set of rosettes to the horses. Juniors riding horses may jump in either the Junior or Senior ring but must stick to one.

**Please state whether you are riding a horse or a pony on your entry form.**

All classes from 2'0" - 3'3" will be Qualifiers for the Cricklands Winter League Finals, held at this venue in April 2018. Achieve a Double Clear in these classes to qualify, please make sure you collect your Qualification Card.
