You will be judged in your section (In Hand or Ridden) and there will be rosettes for each section to include Champion and Reserve and 3rd - 6th.

All exhibits will be required to perform a show not to exceed 2 minutes. Horses will then be selected to go through to the Supreme. The chosen horses from each section will go head to head to compete for the Supreme Champion of Champions title.

All competitors will receive a 'Finalist' rosette for taking part.

Ponies/Horses **MUST** be sound but judging will take into account any marks, bad scarring or blemishes. You will be judged on performance, type, manners, and suitability for the class.

CRICKLANDS SHOW RULES

All competitors take part at their OWN RISK and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed. The organisers and owners of The David Broome Event Centre accept NO responsibility for any accident, loss, or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals or property. It shall be a condition of entry that competitors will hold the organisers blameless and indemnify them against any loss, damage, or legal proceedings.

Cricklands recommend that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance.

All accidents/incidents/falls should be reported to the Secretary.

Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit any Pony/Horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge or his/her immediate family or his/her employer. An exhibitor may not show an equine in a competition judged by any member of his/her immediate family.

An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced an equine within two years of the current year date.

A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition within two years of the current year date.

The Judge's decision will be final.

All times are approx and not before times.

All Ridden Equines MUST be 4 years old & over.

All Colts / Stallions two years old and over must be in possession of a current License (unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society). They must wear a bitted bridle at all times when outside of a stable or horsebox.

IN-HAND STALLIONS AND COLTS:

Stallions / Colts may NOT be LED by any Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

RIDDEN STALLIONS:

Any Pony Stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by juniors who have NOT attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to South West Pony Association. Stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by Juniors who have NOT attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to South West Pony Association. (unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society)

All Children MUST have attained their 3rd birthday by 1st January in the current year before competing in ANY ridden classes, and must comply with the upper limit of the class entered, and be prepared to supply a copy of their birth certificate if requested.

Correct British Standard Headgear conforming to PAS015 or EN1384 or ASTM F1163 or current standards to be worn at all times when mounted, with chinstraps from 3 points on the hat fastened.

Reins that restrict the natural movement of a pony/horse MUST not be used in the ring.

NO Spurs to worn in any ridden class unless standard dress and Showing Canes MUST not exceed 30".

LEAD REIN, FIRST RIDDEN, NOVICE FLAT RIDDEN CLASSES, SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY will be accepted. (Please see list of permitted bits posted outside the Secretary's Office). Wilkies are not accepted as a snaffle and therefore will not be permitted in these classes.

Mountain & Moorland ponies MUST be shown in their natural state and trimming MUST comply with the respective Breed Society Stud Books.

Mountain & Moorland ponies and Part Breds must be registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies and registration numbers to be stated on the entry forms and when entered on the day, (unless otherwise stated on the individual class). These conditions also apply to horses/ponies entered as Pure-bred, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs.

All Foals MUST at least three weeks old on the day of the show. No Foals to be clipped, shod, lunged or shown Bitted. Mountain & Moorland Foals must be eligible for entry into their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books.

The organisers may divide/amalgamate/cancel classes as they see fit, without prior notice.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry of persons or ponies at the committee's / secretary's discretion and without assigning a reason.

ALL dogs MUST be kept on LEADS.

Objections must be in writing and given to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the relevant class and accompanied with a fee of £10.00 (refundable if the objection is upheld)

Parents should be aware that there will be official photographers at this show, and if they do not want their children photographed, THEY MUST make their own arrangements with the photographers. Official photographers ONLY will be allowed in the rings.
