With £200 to the winner of the Supreme Championships and £50 to the winner of the Consolation Finals, it's worth staying on until Sunday to have a go.

The Champion of Champions is open to all exhibitors that have qualified for this competition via the SWPA and Cricklands Shows. Exhibitors must have already pre paid the advance fees requested.

The Champion of Champions is divided into three sections:

- In-Hand
- Mini Ridden
- Ridden

You will be judged in your section (In Hand or Ridden) and there will be rosettes for each section to include Champion and Reserve and 3rd – 6th.

All exhibits will be required to perform a show not to exceed 2 minutes. Horses will then be selected to go through to the Supreme. The chosen horses from each section will go head to head to compete for the Supreme Champion of Champions title.

All competitors will receive a 'Finalist' rosette for taking part.

Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before January 1st in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. To be led by an attendant. Lead Rein attached to the noseband only. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship A. All others qualify for Consolation A.

Class 2 Novice First Ridden (Plaited)

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Not exceeding 128cms. Ponies not to have won any First Ridden class before 1st January in the current year. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before January 1st in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship A. All others qualify for Consolation A.

Class 3 Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, not exceeding 122cms, registered with their respective Breed Society Stud Books. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. To be led by an attendant. Lead Rein attached to the noseband only. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship A. All others qualify for Consolation A.

Class 4 Mountain & Moorland First Ridden

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Not exceeding 128cms, registered with their respective Breed Society Stud Books. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship A. All others qualify for Consolation A.

Class 5 Open Lead Rein

Any Type. Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, not exceeding 122cms, most suitable for, and ridden by a child not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. To be led by an attendant. Lead Rein attached to the noseband only. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship A. All others qualify for Consolation A.

Class 6 Open First Ridden

Any Type. Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Not exceeding 122cms, most suitable for, and ridden by a child not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship A. All others qualify for Consolation A.

Class 7 In-Hand Newbie Junior Handler

Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. This class is an introduction to showing classes for handlers 16 years and under, who consider themselves either a new, nervous or novice at showing. There will be a group go round in walk and trot. A short individual show will be required. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship B. All others qualify for Consolation B.

Class 8 In-Hand Newbie Senior Handler

Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. This class is an introduction to showing classes for handlers over 16 years, who consider themselves either a new, nervous or novice at showing. There will be a group go round in walk and trot. A short individual show will be required. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship B. All others qualify for Consolation B.

Class 9 Newbie Junior Rider

Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. Riders to be correct size for mount. This class is an introduction to showing classes for riders 16 years and under, who consider themselves either a new, nervous or novice rider at showing, never to have won 1st place in a showing class. There will be a group go round in walk and trot. A short individual show will be required. If riders are not happy to canter they may stay at a trot. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by someone on foot. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship B. All others qualify for Consolation B.

Class 10 Newbie Senior Rider

Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. Riders to be correct size for mount. This class is an introduction to showing classes for riders 17 years and over, who consider themselves either a new, nervous or novice rider at showing, never to have won 1st place in a showing class. There will be a group go round in walk and trot. A short individual show will be required. If riders are not happy to canter they may stay at a trot. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by someone on foot. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship B. All others qualify for Consolation B.

Not Before 2pm**Class 11 Novice Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds Ridden**

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, Registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, and Welsh sections A & B. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship C. All others qualify for Consolation C.

Class 12 Novice Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds Ridden

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of New Forest, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland and Welsh sections C & D. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship C. All others qualify for Consolation C.

Class 13 Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds Ridden

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, and Welsh sections A & B. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship C. All others qualify for Consolation C.

Class 14 Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds Ridden

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of New Forest, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland and Welsh sections C & D. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions)

Class 15 Welsh Part Bred Ridden

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship C. All others qualify for Consolation C.

Class 16 Young Handler (4 years to 8 years)

Mare or Gelding. NO STALLIONS OR COLTS. Handlers to have attained their 4th birthday, but not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship B. All others qualify for Consolation B.

Class 17 Young Handler (9 years to 14 years)

Mare or Gelding. NO STALLIONS OR COLTS. Handlers to have attained their 8th birthday, but not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship B. All others qualify for Consolation B.

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of Shetland, Exmoor, Dartmoor, New Forest, Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship D. All others qualify for Consolation D.

Class 23 Coloured Horse/Pony In-Hand Youngstock

Colt, Filly or Gelding. Any Height. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship E. All others qualify for Consolation E.

Class 24 Coloured Horse/Pony In-Hand Four and over

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Any Height. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship E. All others qualify for Consolation E.

Class 25 Traditional Gypsy Cob Type In-Hand

Colt, Filly, Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Any Height. (Special Best Youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship E. All others qualify for Consolation E.

Class 26 Horse/Pony to make Driving Type In-Hand

Colt, Filly, Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Any Height. (Special Best Youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship E. All others qualify for Consolation E.

Class 27 Ridden Coloured n/e 138cms

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Class 29 Ridden Traditional Cob Type (Unplaited)

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. To qualify for TGCA. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Class 30 Ridden Show Cob Type

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Lightweight, Heavyweight or Maxi. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Class 31 Ridden Hunter

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Class 32 Ridden Riding Horse/Hack

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Class 33 Ridden Ex Race Horse

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. Must have competed in an official race run under Jockey Club Rules. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) Must have competed in an official race run under Jockey Club Rules. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Class 34 Ridden Concours d'Elegance

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship F. All others qualify for Consolation F.

Colt, Filly, Gelding, Mare or Stallion. Any age. (Special Best Youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Stallion, Mare, Colt, Filly or Gelding. (Special Best Youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Class 37 Competition Horse / Pony In-Hand

Colt, Filly, Gelding, Mare or Stallion. Any age. (Special Best Youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Class 38 Foreign or Rare Breeds In-Hand (inc' Part Breds)

Colt, Filly, Gelding, Mare or Stallion. Any age. (Special Best Youngstock) Rare Breeds eligible are those on the Critical & Endangered lists. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Class 39 Miniature In-Hand

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Not exceeding 42 inches. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Not Before 11am**Class 40 Hack / Riding Horse In-Hand**

Mare or Gelding. Any age. Hack not to exceed 160cms. Riding Horse to exceed 148cms at Maturity. (Special Best youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Class 41 Hunter In-Hand

Mare or Gelding. Any age. To exceed 148cms. (Special Best youngstock) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Class 42 Ex Race Horse In-Hand

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Any age. Four years old and over. Must have competed in an official race run under Jockey Club Rules. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship G. All others qualify for Consolation G.

Not Before 2pm**Class 43 Ridden Pure, Part Bred & Anglo Arab**

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship I. All others qualify for Consolation I.

Class 44 Foreign or Rare Breeds (inc' Part Breds)

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. Rare Breeds eligible are those on the Critical & Endangered lists (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship I. All others qualify for Consolation I.

Class 45 Ridden Competition Pony/Horse

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship I. All others qualify for Consolation I.

Class 46 Ridden Veteran Horse / Pony

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Fifteen years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions). Exhibitors must display equines age. (Special Rosette to Eldest Pony and Eldest Horse) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship I. All others qualify for Consolation I.

Class 47 Best Turned Out Ridden

To include all types of equine Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) Lead Rein is accepted. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship I. All others qualify for Consolation I.

Class 48 Family Horse / Pony Ridden

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Any Height. To be ridden in a SNAFFLE BRIDLE. NO SPURS or WHIPS/CANES. To be judged on Manners and Suitability. To be ridden by an Adult and Junior with at least ten year age gap. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship I. All others qualify for Consolation I.

Class 49 In-Hand Best Condition & Turnout

Any age. Any Type. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship J. All others qualify for Consolation J.

Class 50 In-Hand Veteran Horse / Pony

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Fifteen years old and over. Exhibitors must display equines age. (Special Rosette to Eldest Pony. Special Rosette to Eldest Horse) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship J. All others qualify for Consolation J.

Class 51 In-Hand Rescue Horse/Pony

Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. There will be a group go round in walk and trot. A short individual show will be required. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship J. All others qualify for Consolation J.

All But Perfect Classes – 9am Start

There is a new type of class long awaited for by owners of Ponies / Horses who are not normally shown due to scarring or blemishes sustained through accident, illness or injury. Ex-Racehorses, Hunters, Riding Horses / Ponies, Rescue cases, the list goes on. Entries in these classes will be judged on the same level, win rosettes and even aim towards the Supreme Championships for prize money. Ponies/Horses MUST be sound but judging will take into account any marks, bad scarring or blemishes. You will be judged on performance, type, manners, and suitability for the class.

Class 52 Best Turned Out Ridden. Plaited & Un-plaited (Including Lead Rein)

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Judged on Turnout of Rider. Tack and Mount. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship K. All others qualify for Consolation K.

Class 53 Best Riding Club Horse/Pony Ridden (Including Lead Rein)

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Competitors to give a short show. (Special rosettes for Best Junior Rider) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship K. All others qualify for Consolation K.

Class 54 Best Ridden Mountain & Moorland

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Competitors to give a short show. (Special rosettes for Best Junior Rider) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship K. All others qualify for Consolation K.

Class 55 Best Ridden Ex Race Horse

Mare or Gelding. Four years and over. Must have competed in an official race run under Jockey Club Rules. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship K. All others qualify for Consolation K.

Class 56 Best Ridden Veteran Horse / Pony

Mare or Gelding. Fifteen years old and over. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Competitors to give a short show. Exhibitors must display equines age. (Special Rosette to Eldest Pony. Special Rosette to Eldest Horse) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship K. All others qualify for Consolation K.

Class 57 Best Ridden Rescued Horse / Pony

Mare or Gelding. Any Breed /Type Height. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Competitors to give a short show. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship K. All others qualify for Consolation K.

Not Before 11am

Class 58 Best Horse / Pony to Hunt

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Any Breed/Type. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Competitors to give a short show. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship L. All others qualify for Consolation L.

Class 59 Ridden Hack / Riding Horse

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Hack not exceeding 160cms. Riding horse exceeding 148cms. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship L. All others qualify for Consolation L.

Class 60 Ridden Cob

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Show Cob exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 155cms. Maxi Cob exceeding 155cms. Riders should be correct size/height for mount. Competitors to give a short show. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship L. All others qualify for Consolation L.

Class 61 Ridden Show Pony / Show Hunter Pony

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Show Pony not exceeding 148cms. Show Hunter Pony not exceeding 153cms. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship L. All others qualify for Consolation L.

Not Before 2pm

Class 62 50cm Working Hunter

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. For any height of horse or pony. Class will be split if there are sufficient entries. (Max Height of Jumps 50cm) Lead Rein Permitted. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship M. All others qualify for Consolation M.

Class 63 60cm Working Hunter

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. For any height of horse or pony. Class will be split if there are sufficient entries. (Max Height of Jumps 60cm) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship M. All others qualify for Consolation M.

Class 64 70cm Working Hunter

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. For any height of horse or pony. Class will be split if there are sufficient entries. (Max Height of Jumps 70cm) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship M. All others qualify for Consolation M.

Class 65 80cm Working Hunter

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. For any height of horse or pony. Class will be split if there are sufficient entries. (Max Height of Jumps 80cm) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship M. All others qualify for Consolation M.

Class 66 90cm Working Hunter

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. For any height of horse or pony. Class will be split if there are sufficient entries. (Max Height of Jumps 90cm) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship M. All others qualify for Consolation M.

Class 67 1m Working Hunter

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. For any height of horse or pony. Class will be split if there are sufficient entries. (Max Height of Jumps 1m) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship M. All others qualify for Consolation M.

Lead Rein attached to the noseband only. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Class 70 Beginners' First Ridden

Any Type. Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Not exceeding 128cms. Ponies not to have won any First Ridden class before 1st January in the current year. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before January 1st in the current year. SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Class 71 Ridden Show Riding Type /Show Hunter Type

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Class 72 Ridden Open M&M

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Not Before 11am

Class 73 Ridden Coloured Horse /Pony

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions) 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Class 74 Ridden Horse /Hunter /Cob

Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Ridden Horse to exceed 148cms. Ridden Hunter to exceed 148cms. Ridden Cob to exceed 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Class 75 Ridden Owner Bred

Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Any Breed. Any Height. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions). To have been bred and produced by owner. 1st and 2nd Qualify for Championship N. All others qualify for Consolation N.

Wentwood 2 Arena – Sunday Morning

If you have qualified for ANY championship, that combination is not eligible for any consolation classes.

9am Start

Consolation Class A

For Exhibitors competing in classes 1-6 but who did not qualify for the Championship Class A. Winner and reserve to qualify for the Consolation Award final.

Consolation Class B

For Exhibitors competing in classes 7-10 and 16-17 but who did not qualify for the Championship Class B. Winner and reserve to qualify for the Consolation Award final.

Consolation Class C

For Exhibitors competing in classes 11-15 but who did not qualify for the Championship Class C. Winner and reserve to qualify for the Consolation Award final.

Consolation Class D

For Exhibitors competing in classes 18-22 but who did not qualify for the Championship Class D. Winner and reserve to qualify for the Consolation Award final
